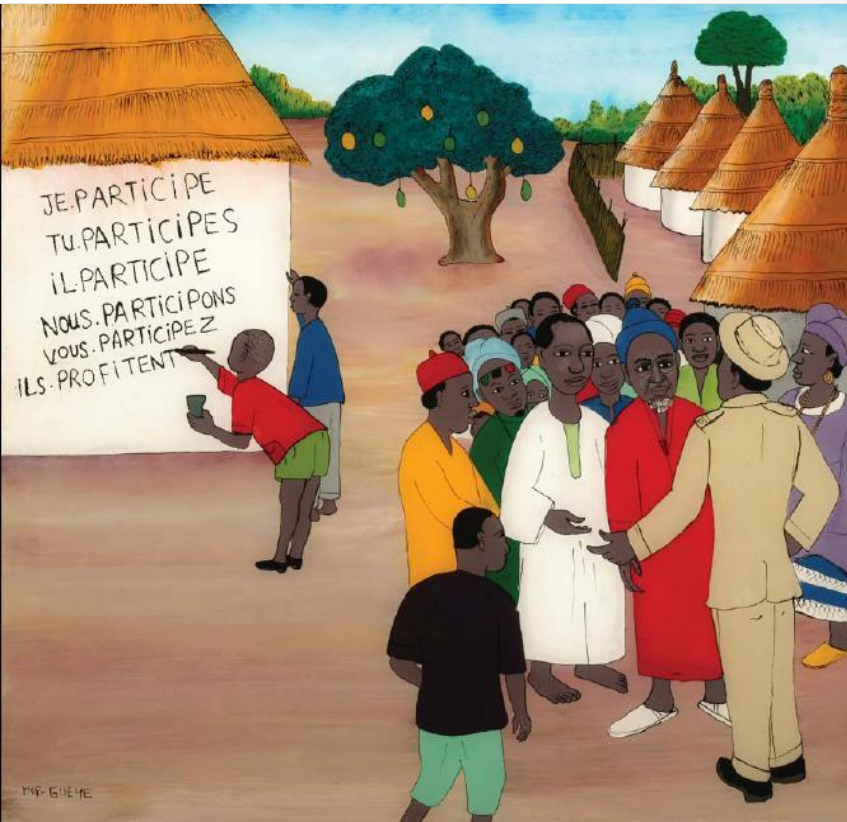

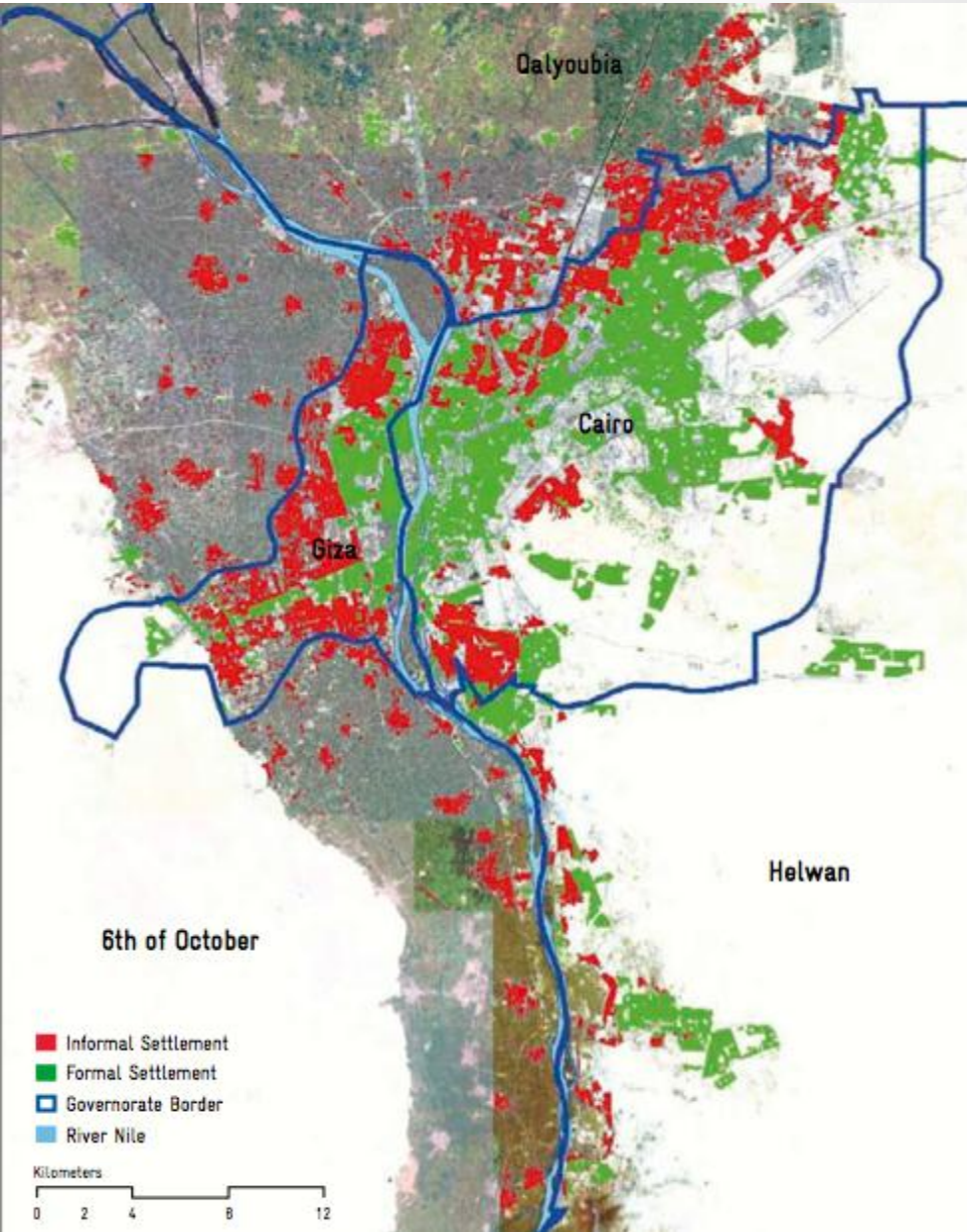

- Improvement of the legal status of women
- Regional learning (Algerian budget and audit principles)
- Modern audit techniques – widening the audit scope and allowing a more thorough control of state enterprise
- Regional Governance Network across institutions – among Secretary Generals
- Establishing oommon topics across the region: transitional justice.
