## Some basic facts

### History of the Practitioners Network

- First **informal meeting** in November 2005 in order to establish first contacts, share needs and expectations from an **enlarged EU donor community perspective and to** ultimately, to draw upon ways to facilitate the exchange of information and practices amongst all the European actors, at the implementation level.
- Second meeting (**official**) in February 2007, in which over 20 different European donor organisations participated. There it was decided to create an informal European network of practitioners.
- Two **Annual Meetings** have been convened, next **AM** hosted by AECID in May 2010, Madrid, Spain

### Structure of the Network

- The Core Group (in charge of securing and coordinating the network activities as well as the operational steering of the network)
- The Secretariat (permanent structure, supporting the Core Group)
- The Thematic Groups (deal with themes of cooperation which have been deemed relevant for long-term collaboration between interested participants)
  - Climate Change, Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energies
  - Institutional Development and Human Resources
  - Quality Management
  - Division of Labour and Modes of Delivery
